AN ACT CONCERNING PARENTAL ALIENATION

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

January , 2008 Session

1. An Act preventing one parent from unilaterally enrolling a child or children in a Day
2. Center, Private, Religious or Public School. Institutions must report the intent to enroll
3. to the Department of Children and Families. They will in turn make a criminal complaint
4. to local authorities (police). The offending partie will loose custody and the offended
5. partie will assume custody. A fine is also to be imposed in addition to loss of custody.
6. A higher fine will be imposed for children under the age of six.

Statement of Purpose:

7. To prevent the kidnapping or alienation of children from one parent. To make the act a criminal offence and to protect children from parental alienation. To protect the rights of a parent from parental alienation. To prevent this prima face' act of child abuse.

Note: Bills this Session can only be introduced to Commitiees. Legislators Cannot introduce the Bills.
